The following modules did not have any changes made to Application Preferences: Dashboard Settings, Daycare, Grooming, Credit Card Settings, Order Processing, Email Reminders, Miscellaneous, Scheduled Services, Group Training.

BOARDING SETTINGS:

Show All Boarding Types on Calendar. With this preference selected you can see Active, Pending Deposit, Requested, and Wait List, boardings on the calendar.

Show All Boarding Types On Calendar When selected, will show all boarding types except for deleted boardings on the Boarding Calendar.	<input checked="" type="checkbox"/>

Disable Boarding Pets Error Checking. New with PetExec 3.2 when scheduling a boarding with 3 pets who are siblings, PetExec will provide an error message when the # of pets fields do not match the number of pets selected for that boarding. Checking this preference will disable that error checking.

Disable Boarding Pets Error Checking When selected will not check the number of pets indicated under "Available Pets" against the "# of Pets" entered in the boarding services section. With this error checking disabled, the number of pets in house may not be accurate, which may impact the Boarding Count report.	<input type="checkbox"/>

<p>Disable Boarding # of Pets When selected, will force the entering of # of Pets being used in a boarding. Unselected, it will automatically default to "1" pet.</p>	<input type="checkbox"/>	
<p>Disable Boarding # of Kennels When selected, will force the entering of # Kennels being used in a boarding. Unselected, it will automatically default to "1" kennel.</p>	<input type="checkbox"/>	

CUSTOMER SETTINGS:

Modified Enable Boarding Schedule For Owners: You still have the option to select if you want owners to "schedule" boardings or "request" boardings appts. You also now have the option to select how you want your scheduling options to be displayed for your owners. If you have not made any changes to your boarding products and services with PetExec 3.3, the we recommend using Option A. If you consider making changes to your boarding products and services to utilize the new Qty/Day field, we recommend testing out Option B to see how you prefer allowing your owners to schedule/request in the PetExec Owner Portal.
